Elective subject: Guardians of Nature

Grade 3rd - Topics:

- Responsible ownership relating to dogs as pets
- I am not a stray dog I am an abandon dog
- Solution still exists...(for stray dogs)

Grade 4th - Topics:

- Your new puppy – useful tips (such as: healthcare of dogs and training of dogs)
- Your new kitten – useful tips (healthcare for cats, cat behaviour and misapprehensions about cats)
- Prevention and avoiding of dog bites

Grade 6th - Topics:

- Responsible attitude towards animals
- Animal rights – survival of animals depends on man
- Welfare of pet animals
- Welfare of farm animals, experimental animals and fur animals
- Care for abandoned animals

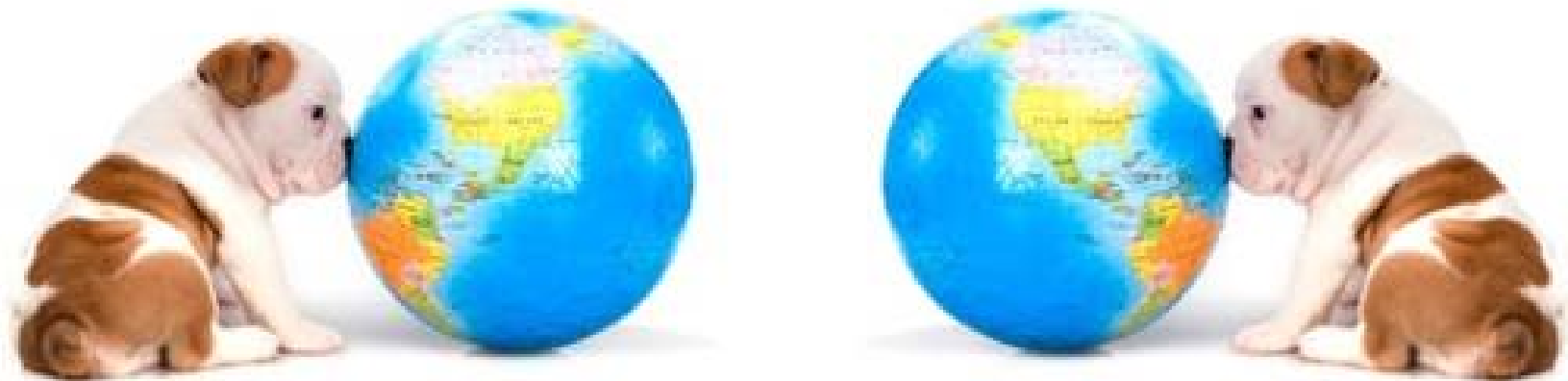
