**Job title:** Veterinary Adviser

**Position reports to:** Director of Veterinary Department

### **Job purpose Summary:**

Work with the Director to produce policy papers and delivery in areas of:

- Anti-doping and medication matters (Clean Sport), rolling out global Medication Control at FEI events,
- Welfare, including relevant required studies,
- Veterinary needs for the FEI disciplines,
- Coordination of laboratories, and the FEI List Group,
- Research and development projects.

### **Area of responsibility:**

All matters related to the FEI veterinary regulatory environment for competition horses.

Working closely with targeted external stakeholders:

- NF's, Veterinarians, FEI officials riders, major stakeholders in the scientific community
- NGOs, owners etc specifically in areas of Doping and Medication
- Governments

Working closely with internal stakeholders

- Education and Development
- Legal Department
- Veterinary and other technical committees as required
- Disciplines
- FEI Media and Communications department

## **Key Responsibilities:**

### **CLEAN SPORT (ANTI DOPING AND MEDICATION)**

#### **FEI List Group**

- Assist with managing the FEI List group and regular meetings
- Assist with developing and managing the FEI list of Detection Times

#### **Liaison with legal / Clean Sport initiative**

- Provide general information and expertise on veterinary matters
- Provide advice on equine medication control testing and implementation

#### **Veterinarians, riders, owners, manufacturers and NFs**

- Follow up of questions from all listed stakeholders
- Preparation of suitable FAQs and use of the website as required

#### **Medication Control Programmes (MCP)**

- Preparation of MCP figures and rolling out MCP in new regions of the world

### **HORSE WELFARE**

#### **Hypersensitization**

- Assist with coordination, organizing, evaluating and improving hypersensitization controls

#### **Injuries**

- Assist with the development of an FEI injuries database

#### **FEI Welfare Code**

- Produce guidance to support the FEI welfare Code as required
- Support projects and monitor research undertaken to support horse welfare

### **EDUCATION and COMMUNICATION**

#### **Veterinary Officials**

- Assist with provision of suitable and trained Veterinary officials for events
- Assist with ensuring standard approach to doping controls, welfare and horse movement

#### **FEI Veterinary courses and outside Veterinary meetings**

- Preparing and delivering presentations on various veterinary issues
- Establish contacts with veterinary authorities and other organizations

### **ADMINISTRATION**

- As required liaise with governments and Organising Committees
- Assist with developing the NF and FEI Head National Veterinarian network
- Assist with FEI passport and identification issues
